A Sample of Five Day
Itinerary in Torres del
Paine, Patagonia, Chile

Day 1



WELCOME TO Torres del Paine, Patagonia, Chile. Take your time to embrace the breathtaking views of **Paine Massif** and **Pehoé Lake** offered by our privileged location inside **Torres del Paine National Park**.

Our guides will welcome you and introduce the explorations that are most suitable for you. Plan the following days striking your own balance between **adventure and wellness**.

On your first day, a gentle walk along the nearby lookouts will give you a glimpse of what's to come in the days ahead.

Restore your energy at the **Casa de Baños Ona** and submerge in the heated pool, or in the warmth of the outdoor hot tubs. Relax, breathe and enjoy the views that merge with the turquoise waters of the **Paine River**, flowing slowly from the glaciers.

Day 2

WAKE UP to majestic views and prepare for a day of exploration.

We will cross **Pehoé Lake** by catamaran to the **Paine Grande refuge** where we start the hike. Enter the **French Valley** through a lush forest of native species like lenga, coigüe and ñirre, refuge to a unique biodiversity. Feel the scent of the moist earth and take in all the beauty of the **Patagonian wilderness**, something you can only do up close. We then continue our hike towards **Italian Camp**. From there, we will see the glacier and the imposing amphitheatre of mountains and **granite peaks**. The views of the horns completely dominate the scene and inspire awe with their impressive beauty.

Day 3

TODAY WE WILL WANDER deep into the Southern Patagonian icefields. **Grey Glacier** is one of the largest found in **Torres del Paine National Park** and we will approach it by catamaran, coming face-to-face with its imposing **30 meter high ice walls**. On our way to the glacier we will progressively discover the impact it has on the valley and the lake's geography, the **floating icebergs** and the diverse ecosystems that are born from it.

Finish an exciting day with a drink at our **explorers' bar**, famous for the tales of travelers and a place where wonder is always fresh. Connect in unique experiences and **enjoy exchanging stories** with other travelers.

Day 4

VENTURE INTO the surprising landscapes of the Patagonian steppe; its **open plains and extensive pampas** offer a dramatic contrast with the mountains that surround it. From this distance you can get some of the best views of the Torres, the perfect setting for a **memorable photo shoot** and also known for its close encounters with local wildlife such as guanacos, flamingos and even pumas, if fortunate enough; as well as the **4000 year old cave paintings** left behind by the ancient inhabitants of this land.

Between November and April, you can finish the **gaucho experience** with an authentic Patagonian **wood-fired barbecue**, a ritual that is ready just in time to enjoy a long, relaxing lunch in our quincho, ending with a warm mate infusion around a campfire telling stories and sharing **Patagonian culture**.

Day 5

EXPLORING PATAGONIA on horseback is a whole new and exciting perspective.

The **gaucho lifestyle** has been tied to their horses for generations, they have been specifically bred for this climate and geography. We depart the Explora stables with a gentle trot through the **pampas and wetlands**, we ride through diverse terrains appreciating the beauty of each landscape.

No matter what your level of expertise, a **horseback experience** is well worthwhile, offering unique views of the **Paine Massif**, the **Patagonian steppe**, and different lookout points. We return to our stables and finish with a rewarding **mate infusion** and a day full of gaucho adventures.

Make the most of this last night with us, take in all of the Patagonian experience and the majestic beauty you have encountered **in these 5 days**. We hope to see you again soon.
